## VaSAM 2023 Annual Conference

More than two-hundred attendees gathered at the Virginia Beach Marriott Oceanfront Resort November 3-4, 2023 to take part in the VaSAM 2023 Workshops & Annual Conference. Over the course of the two-day event, attendees from across Virginia and eleven (11) other states learned from fourteen outstanding speakers and panelists on a range of Addiction Medicine topics.

Nine (9) students participated in the Student/Medical Trainee Poster Competition with the top honors going to Augustus M. White, of VCU School of Medicine, who won the Sherman Master, MD Memorial Scholarship Award (Judge's Choice Award) and Jason T. Bard, of Eastern Virginia Medical School, who won the K. LeGree Hallmann Memorial Award (People's Choice Award).

















